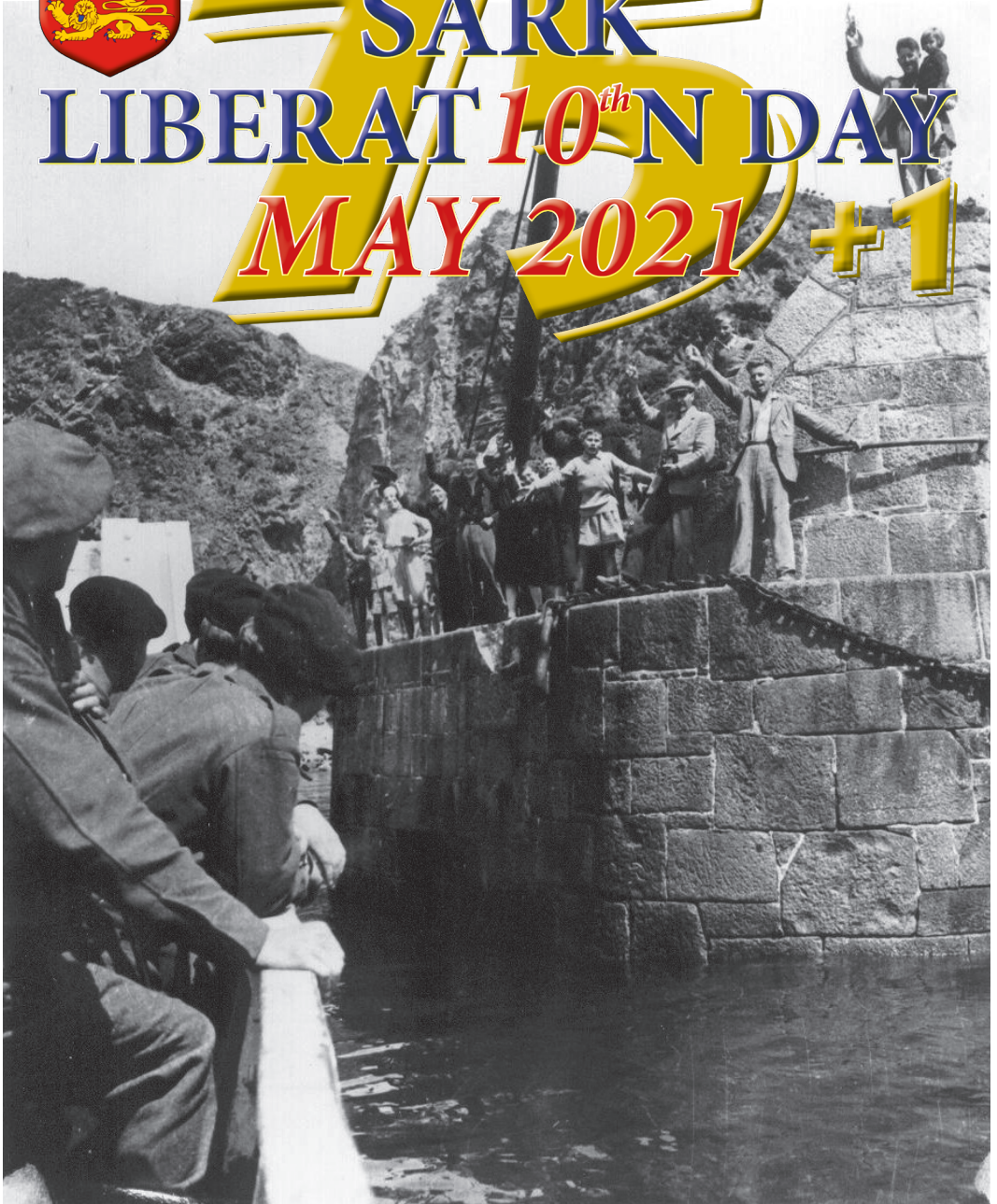




SARK LIBERAT^{10th} N DAY MAY 2021 +1
